

## How to disable HP automatic firmware update

**These instructions are suitable for HP printers using compatible ink cartridges**

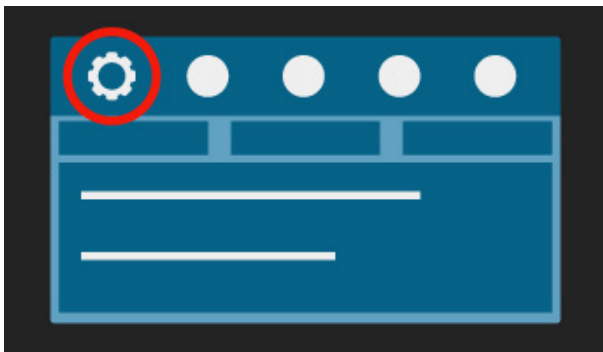
The default setting for your printer is usually checked for automatic firmware updates. This means that your printer will automatically install firmware updates without prompting when they become available.

Once the firmware update is completed, the next time you install a non original cartridge, your printer may display a cartridge problem. This is to prevent you from using non original cartridges.

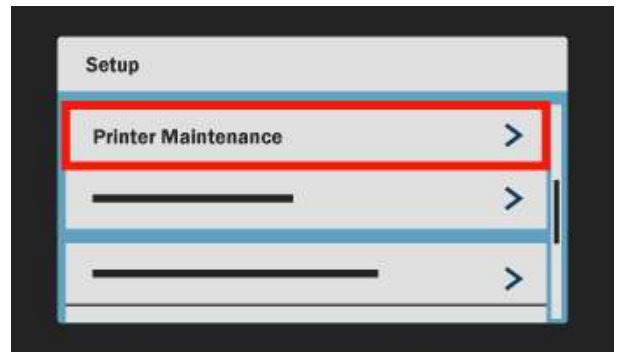
If your printer works fine with third party cartridges and you want to continue using them, we recommend that you turn off the "Printer Update" function in your printer.

**Please follow the instructions below:**

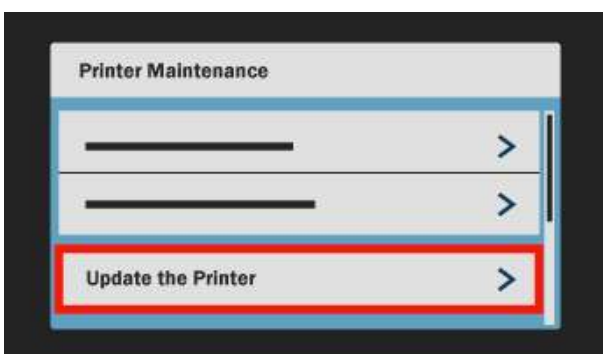
**Step 1: Swipe down and then select the setup icon.**



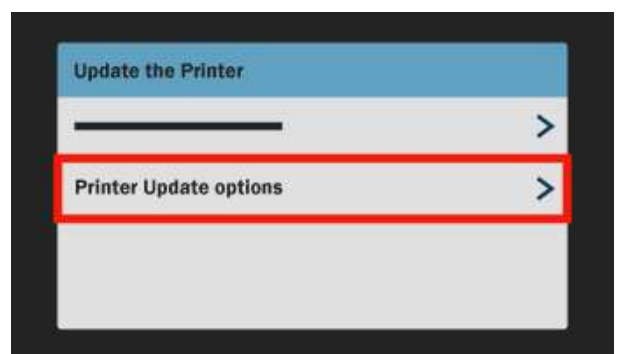
**Step 2: Select "Printer Maintenance"**



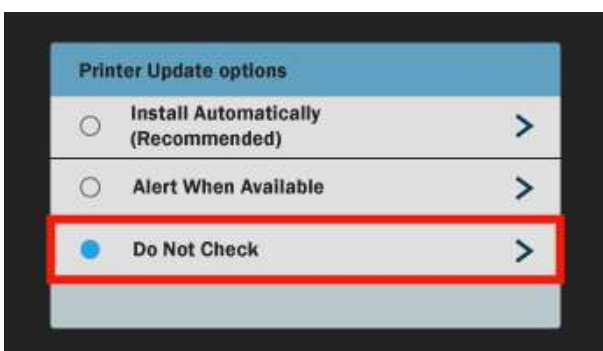
**Step 3: Select "Update the Printer"**



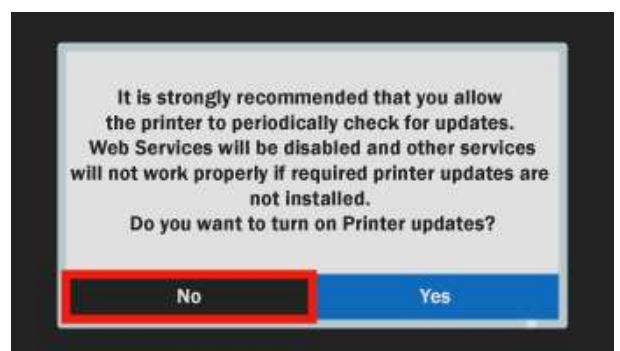
**Step 4: Select "Printer Update Options"**



**Step 5: Select "Do Not Check"**



**Step 6: Select "No" to turn off printer updates**



# How to get around HP Firmware Block

1. From the home screen, press the unlit "Return" icon three times very quickly. The display screen will change to show "Support Menu"
2. Press "Support Menu"
3. Use the up / down arrows to select "Reset Menu" & press "OK".
4. You can select either of two choices: "Partial Reset" or "Semi-Full Reset" – use this one to clear the admin lock and return the printer to its out-of-box settings. Selecting this will turn the printer off, so you'll need to turn it on again.
